AHA Ventilation Guidance for Facility Directors, Nurse Managers, and Clinicians

As part of the Project Firstline initiative, the American Society for Health Care Engineering (ASHE), in collaboration with the American Hospital Association (AHA), has released a new resource, the Guidance. This Guidance is designed to educate health care workers, staff, and facility managers so that they can confidently make knowledgeable evidence-based decisions regarding ventilation in health care settings to keep patients and staff safe and reduce chance of contamination and infection from diseases that spread through the air.

The AHA and ASHE are working together to highlight the importance of using a multidisciplinary approach toward infection prevention and control (IPC) through their participation in Project Firstline.

Project Firstline is a national training collaborative led by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) that aims to provide effective health care infection control training for millions of frontline U.S. health care workers and members of the public health workforce in the fight against infectious disease threats.

ASHE Update Advocacy Announcement

ASHE advocacy team to address sprinkler system compliance at NFPA Tech Meeting

ASHE advocacy leaders will be testifying June 8 at the 2022 NFPA Technical Meeting. The advocacy team will address sprinkler system compliance and the debate surrounding minor items such as duct installation, flex conduit and IT cables coming into contact with sprinkler pipes. Their testimony will be based on evidence from ASHE's Sprinkler System Support Analysis monograph, which reviews the history of NFPA 13 and NFPA 25, and also examines findings from 10 surveys at existing health care facilities.
